Eligibility for B. Pharm / M. Pharm.

Students who want to join the Pharmacy Program have to fulfill the given eligibility criteria:

Eligibility criteria for B. Pharm.

Maharashtra State Candidature Candidates:

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory Subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology
- Obtained at least 50% marks for open category
- At least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class Categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together.
- The candidate should have appeared in all the subjects in MHT-CET and obtain non zero score in MHT-CET.
- Should obtain non zero positive score in NEET or the candidate should have appeared in all the subjects in **MHT-CET 2020** and obtain non zero score in **MHTCET 2020**.

All India Candidature Candidates:

- The candidate should be an Indian National
- Passed HSC or its equivalent examination with Physics and Chemistry as compulsory Subjects along with one of the Mathematics or Biology.
- Obtained at least 50% marks for open category.
- At least 45% marks in case of candidates of Backward class categories and Persons with Disability belonging only to Maharashtra State) in the above subjects taken together.
- Should obtain non zero positive score in NEET or the candidate should have appeared in all

the subjects in **MHT-CET 2020** and obtain non zero score in **MHTCET 2020**.

- However, preference shall be given to the candidate obtaining non zero positive score in NEET over the candidates who obtained non zero score in **MHTCET 2020**.

Intake Capacity: 60 Seats

Course Duration: 8 Semesters (4 Years Degree Course)

Eligibility criteria for Direct second year admission for B. Pharm

- Candidate should be Indian National
- Students should have passed Post HSC Diploma Course in Pharmacy with at least 50 % marks for open category.
- 45 % marks in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging only to Maharashtra State
- Students should pass from an AICTE/ PCI approved institutes with English as the medium of instruction at diploma level.
- Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time

Intake Capacity: 12 Seats

Course Duration: 6 Semesters (3 Years Degree Course)

Eligibility criteria for M. Pharm

- Students who have passed B. Pharmacy from any AICTE & PCI approved institute only are eligible to take for admission to M. Pharm.
- They must have obtained at least with 50% of marks for Open category & 45% of marks for other backward category & none zero score in GPAT.
- Any other criterion declared by appropriate authority from time to time

Intake: Capacity: 15 seats

Course Duration: 4 Semesters (2 Years Full time Course)
